

DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Mindanao as of 25 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 January 2025 at around 6:19 PM, heavy rains caused by the localized thunderstorms resulted in a flash flood affecting seven (7) low-lying barangays in Koronadal City, South Cotabato. On 08 January 2025, at around 3:00 AM, the same weather conditions triggered flooding in several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

On 09 January 2025 at around 5:57 PM, municipalities of Isulan in Sultan Kudarat, Norala, Sto. Niño in South Cotabato, and Sultan Sa Barongis in Maguindanao del Sur experienced flash floods. On the same day, an incident of rain-induced mudslide/mudflow was also reported in Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat brought by the localized thunderstorms.

On 10 January 2025 at around 5 PM, several barangays in the municipalities of Datu Abdullah Sangki and Shariff Saydona Mustapha in Maguindanao del Sur experienced flash floods brought by the localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **22,798 families** or **72,317 persons** are affected in **46 barangays** in **Regions XII and Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM)** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **30 families** or **114 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Region XII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **two (2) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

One (1) family or **two (2) persons** are still displaced in **Region XII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1) is totally damaged** and **one (1) is partially damaged** in **Santo Niño, South Cotabato** and **Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱17,010,040.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
