

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Bayotbot, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro

21 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 February 2025 at around 8:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 68th Infantry (Kaagapay) Battalion, 4th Infantry (Scorpion) Battalion and the New People's Army of the Southern Tagalog Regional Party Committee (NPA STRPC) at Sitio Kalinisan, Brgy. Bayotbot, San Jose Occidental Mindoro.

Relative to this incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the MIMAROPA Region, swiftly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

A total of **eight (8) families** or **46 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Bayotbot, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **eight (8) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱12,009.10** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱8,009.10** from **DSWD** and **₱4,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
