

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 1, City of San Fernando, La Union

27 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 February 2025 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 1, City of San Fernando, La Union.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **four (4) families** or **25 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 1**, **City of San Fernando**, **La Union** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **four (4) families** or **25 persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 1, City of San Fernando, La Union** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱189,969.04** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱169,969.04** from **DSWD** and **₱20,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
