

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ferdinand, Baguio City

I. Situation Overview

On 10 December 2024 at around 7:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Ferdinand, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 9:25 AM.

A total of **six (6) families** or **17 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Ferdinand, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **six (6) families** or **17 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Ferdinand, Baguio City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱141,879.04** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱88,879.04** from **DSWD** and **₱53,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
