

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Antonio, San Pedro City, Laguna

11 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 January 2025 at around 8:16 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Southridge, Brgy. San Antonio, San Pedro City, Laguna. The fire was declared out at around 8:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **23 families** or **98 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Antonio**, **San Pedro City, Laguna** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **12 families** or **57 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Southridge Baptist Church** in **Brgy. San Antonio, San Pedro City, Laguna** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **11 families** or **41 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **23 families** or **98 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. San Antonio**, **San Pedro City, Laguna** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **23 houses** were damaged; of which, **21** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Antonio, San Pedro City, Laguna** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱45,296.66 worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).
