

# DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tonsuya, Malabon City

02 February 2025, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 05 January 2025 at around 2:29 PM, a fire incident occurred at Flovihomes Phase 6, Brgy. Tonsuya, Malabon City. The fire was declared out at around 3:14 PM.

In response, the DSWD, through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱25,715.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
