

## **DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tres de Mayo, City of Digos, Davao del Sur**

02 February 2025, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 24 December 2024 at around 3:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Yellowbell, Brgy. Tres de Mayo, City of Digos, Davao del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 6:29 PM.
