Situation Overview L

Issued on 28 September 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to some areas in the country. On the same day, Brgy. Lagumit, Malita, Davao Occidental experienced a flash flood incident due to localized thunderstorms.
