

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Biga-A, Barbaza, Antique

13 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2025 at around 11:00 AM, a strong wind incident occurred in Brgy. Biga-A, Barbaza, Antique. The said incident resulted in damages to a house.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Barbaza, Antique, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or nine (9) persons were affected in Brgy. Biga-A, Barbaza, Antique (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or nine (9) persons sought temporary shelter in Brgy. Biga-A Health Center in, Barbaza, Antique (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Biga-A, Barbaza, Antique (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}9,978.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of \$\mathbb{P}4,978.00\$ from **DSWD** and \$\mathbb{P}5,000.00\$ from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).


