

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Armyworm in San Francisco, Cebu

29 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 June 2024, a fall armyworm infestation was first reported in Barangays Consuelo and Southern Poblacion in San Francisco, Cebu. Subsequently, 13 other barangays were reported to have experienced widespread armyworm infestations, which resulted in substantial damage and loss of livelihood among the farmers in the municipality.
