

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon

05 February 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

Issued on 12 July 2024 at 4:00 AM, the Southwest Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains to the western sections of Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao

On the same day, heavy rainfall in Datu Montawal (Papagawan), Maguindanao del Sur caused the Pulangi / Rio Grande de Mindanao River to rise and consequently, resulted to flooding in some low-lying barangays. Sustained heavy rains also caused the Tual, Nalus, and Pangi Rivers to overflow and subsequently submerge several houses in Kiamba, Sarangani.

On 12 July 2024, several areas in Zamboanga Peninsula including Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur, and Zamboanga del Norte, experienced flooding due to continuous rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon.

Furthermore, extreme rainfall was also experienced in the flood-prone barangays in LGU of Kalilangan, Bukidnon resulting in flash floods in the area.

On 13 July 2024, Mandaue City and Santa Catalina, Negros Oriental, experienced flooding and landslide incident brought by the effects of Southwest Monsoon.

On 14 July 2024, heavy rainfall was experienced in the municipality of Igaras, Iloilo. Meanwhile, the municipalities of Leon and Pototan in Iloilo reported a landslide incident due to continuous rainfall brought by the effects of Southwest Monsoon on 15 July 2024.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **179,229 families** or **876,034 persons** were affected in **451 barangays** in **Regions VI, VII, IX, X, XI, XII, and BARMM** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **20,639 families** or **96,858 persons** sought temporary shelter in **94 evacuation centers** in **Regions VII, IX, X, XI, XII, and BARMM** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **35,015 families** or **175,138 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

**c. Total Displaced Population**

A total of **55,654 families** or **271,996 persons** were displaced in **Regions VI, VII, IX, X, XI, XII, and BARMM** (see Annex D).

**IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **222 houses** were damaged; of which, **98 are totally damaged** and **124 are partially damaged** in **Regions VI, VII, IX, X, XI, and XII** (see Annex E).

**V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱92,660,532.26** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱87,969,632.26** from **DSWD** and **₱4,690,900.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
