

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

21 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2025 at around 8:18 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **42 families** or **77 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **42 families** or **77 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 11 houses were damaged; of which, seven (7) are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. 17, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱786,904.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱331,724.00 from DSWD, and ₱455,180.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
