

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City

05 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 December 2024 around 2:24 AM, a fire incident occurred at 17G Lions Road, Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 4:22 AM.

A total of **85 families** or **359 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **85 families** or **359 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya Covered Court** in **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **59 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱502,836.10** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
