

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City

21 May 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2025 at around 6:20 PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 7:04 PM. Several residential structures were destroyed, displacing numerous residents in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **eight (8) families** or **27 persons** were affected in **Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

- a. Inside Evacuation Center
 A total of seven (7) families or 24 persons sought temporary shelter at a chapel in Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex B).
- b. Outside Evacuation Center
 One (1) family or three (3) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex D).
- c. Total Displaced Population
 A total of eight (8) families or 27 persons were displaced in Brgy. San Jose,
 Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **eight (8) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Jose, Arevalo, Iloilo City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱123,400.20 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱60,660.00 from DSWD and ₱62,740.20 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
