

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Landslide Incident in Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte

25 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 30 January 2025 at 2:30 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms caused by Shear Line may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy with at times intense rains in Eastern Visayas.

On the same day, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Ayahag, Brgy. Nueva Esperanza, and Brgy. Sug-angon in Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte which caused damages to residential houses.
