

## **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. General Luna, Toboso, Negros Occidental** as of 19 March 2025, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 18 March 2025 at around 3:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Bairan, Brgy. General Luna, Toboso, Negros Occidental between the Philippine Army's 79th Infantry Battalion and the alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VI, actively engaged in the response operations and extended relief assistance comprising food and non-food items to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **113 families** or **387 persons** are affected in **Brgy. General Luna, Toboso, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **102 families** or **351 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. General Luna, Toboso, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **11 families** or **36 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **113 families** or **387 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. General Luna, Toboso, Negros Occidental** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱453,214.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱193,214.00** from **DSWD** and **₱260,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
