

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro

as of 04 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 March 2025 at around 10:15 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Lomboy, Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro between the Philippine Army's 4th Infantry Battalion and the members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 303 families or 1,515 persons are affected in Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 303 families or 1,515 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Salay Elementary School in Brgy. Panaytayan, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P75,750.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** affected families (see Annex C).
