

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Cabanglasan, Bukidnon

## I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2025, an armed conflict transpired between the government troops of the 4th Infantry Division and members of the New People’s Army in the mountains in Cabanglasan, Bukidnon.

A total of **154 families** or **770 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Cabanglasan, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).
