

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Shear Line in Eastern Visayas

as of 20 March 2025, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 19 March 2025 at around 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms caused by Shear Line may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Eastern Visayas, Sorsogon, Masbate, Aklan, and Capiz.

On the same day, due to the continuous heavy rainfall caused by Shear Line, a landslide incident occurred at San Miguel-Babatngon Road, San Miguel, Leyte.

Meanwhile, a flooding incident also occurred at the Wright-Taft-Borongan Road, Brgy. Malinao, Taft. Both incidents led to impassable roads.

A total of 11,077 families or 38,320 persons are affected in 68 barangays in Region VIII (see Annex A).
