

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Baseco Compound, Port Area, Tondo, Manila City as of 18 March 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 March 2025 at around 4:19 PM, a fire incident occurred at Block 15-B, Baseco Compound, Port Area, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:51 PM.

A total of **88 families** or **293 persons** are affected in **Baseco Compound, Port Area, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **88 families** or **293 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Baseco Covered Court** in **Baseco Compound, Port Area, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **25 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Baseco Compound, Port Area, Manila City** (see Annex C).
