

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2, Caloocan City

as of 13 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 February 2025 at around 11:34 AM, a fire incident occurred at Cayabyab St., Brgy. 2, Sangandaan, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 12:05 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **37 families** or **95 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 2, Caloocan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **37 families** or **95 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **BGI Covered Court** in **Caloocan City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of eight (8) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 2, Caloocan City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P171,722.92** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
