# I. Situation Overview

On 09 March 2025 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families** or **12 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are three (3) families or 12 persons currently taking temporary shelter in ABES 2 in Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. 2 (Pob.), Bacolod City (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱31,860.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱18,990.00 from DSWD and ₱12,870.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
