I. Situation Overview

On 08 March 2025 at around 2:02 AM, a fire incident occurred at Milagros St., corner Bambang St., Brgy. 317, Sta. Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 3:46 AM.

There are **75 families** or **211 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Barangay 317 Hall evacuation center** in **Brgy. 317, Sta. Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex B).

12 houses were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 317, Sta. Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex C).
