

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 602, Sta. Mesa, Manila City as of 13 March 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2025 at around 10:48 AM, a fire incident occurred at V. Mapa Extension Corner Pat Antonio St., Brgy. 602, Sta. Mesa, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:40 PM.
