I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2025 at around 10:48 AM, a fire incident occurred at V. Mapa Extension Corner Pat Antonio St., Brgy. 602, Sta.Mesa, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:40 PM.

- 580,495 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 218,905 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 361,590 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 53,010 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱161.38 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
