

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Arado, Tanauan, Leyte as of 25 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 March 2025 at around 11:25 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Arado, Tanauan, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 11:35 AM.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Arado, Tanauan, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Arado, Tanauan, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,197.10** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
