I. Situation Overview

On 13 March 2025 at around 11:25 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy.Arado, Tanauan, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 11:35 AM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Arado, Tanauan, Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Arado, Tanauan, Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,197.10** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
