#### I. Situation Overview

On 03 March 2025 at around 10:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Balabag, Malay, Aklan. The fire was declared out on 04 March 2025 at around 1:30 AM.

A total of **14 families** or **34 persons** are affected in **Brgy**. **Balabag**, **Malay**, **Aklan** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **14 families or 34 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Balabag, Malay, Aklan (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P33,528.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
