

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basing, Binmaley, Pangasinan as of 15 March 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 March 2025, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Basing, Binmaley, Pangasinan. Due to the incident, five (5) individuals were affected resulting in partial damage to their house.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through its Field Office (FO) I, has already processed the request for relief augmentation from the Local Government Unit (LGU). The assistance is now ready for distribution for the affected individuals.
