

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cacadiran, Cabugao, Ilocos Sur as of 04 March 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 February 2025 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Rebba, Brgy. Cacadiran, Cabugao, Ilocos Sur.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families** or **eight (8) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cacadiran, Cabugao, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **three (3) families** or **eight (8) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Cacadiran, Cabugao, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱39,939.03** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱34,119.03** from **DSWD** and **₱5,820.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
