

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Calaparan, Arevalo, Iloilo City

as of 12 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 March 2025 at around 4:34 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 14, Brgy. Calaparan, Arevalo, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 5:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of eight (8) families or 30 persons are affected in Brgy. Calaparan, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are six (6) families or 22 persons currently taking temporary shelter in the BNC Office in Brgy. Calaparan, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or eight (8) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are eight (8) families or 30 persons still displaced in Brgy. Calaparan, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Calaparan, Arevalo, Iloilo City (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P64,310.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).
