

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Calumpang, Molo, Iloilo City as of 22 March 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2025 at around 12:03 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy, Calumpang, Molo, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 12:28 PM.

A total of **three (3) families** or **15 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Calumpang, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **15 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Chapel** in **Brgy. Calumpang, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Calumpang, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex D).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱20,010.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
