

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City as of 22 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 February 2025 at around 9:12 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 10:15 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **28 families** or **79 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **28 families** or **79 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Nazareth Covered Court** in **Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **eight (8)** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱317,926.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱238,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱79,926.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
