

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 06 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2025 at around 11:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 3, V. Castro St., Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 12:36 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 12 families or 22 persons are affected in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There were seven (7) families or 12 persons who took temporary shelter at Barangay Carmen National High School in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱57,084.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex D).
