

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 12 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 February 2025 at around 2:50 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 3:52 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 17 families or 33 persons are affected in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There were 10 families or 19 persons who took temporary shelter at Brgy. Carmen National High School in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P222,685.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P141,986.00** from **DSWD** and **P80,699.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
