as of 26 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2025 at around 3:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Del Pilar, Maydolong, Eastern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 4:20 PM.

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are affected in Brgy. Del Pilar, Maydolong, Eastern Samar (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house is totally damaged in Brgy. Del Pilar, Maydolong, Eastern Samar (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,620.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
