

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City as of 08 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 March 2025 at around 7:20 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 8:23 PM.

A total of **86 families** or **350 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **86 families** or **350 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Ibabao Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

A total of **40 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Ibabao-Estancia, Mandaue City** (see Annex C).
