I. Situation Overview

On 27 February 2025 at around 6:59 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City, and it was declared fire out at around 9:41 PM.

A total of **60 families** or **256 persons** are affected in **Brgy**. **Lahug**, **Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **60 families** or **256 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Lahug Elementary School Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **41 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Lahug, Cebu City** (see Annex C).
