I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2025 at around 4:44 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 16, Carson St., Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 6:50 PM.

A total of **97 families** or **201 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **97 families** or **201 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Udha Gym Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **30 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Lubogan, Davao City** (see Annex C).
