# I. Situation Overview

On 22 March 2025 at around 12:08 PM, a fire incident occurred at Area 4 Pinalagad, Brgy. Malinta, Valenzuela City. The fire was declared out at around 5:40 PM.

A total of **60 families** or **188 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Malinta, Valenzuela City** (see Annex A).

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **60 families** or **188 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Pinalagad Elementary School** in **Brgy. Malinta, Valenzuela City** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Malinta, Valenzuela City** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱337,694.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
