I. Situation Overview

On 03 March 2025 at around 2:58 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 4:42 PM.

There are 120 families or 500 persons currently taking temporary shelter in the Barangay Gymnasium of Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City (see Annex B).

A total of **80 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Mantuyong, Mandaue City** (see Annex C).
