

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar

as of 26 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 March 2025 at around 02:35 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar. The fire was declared out at around 04:40 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **41 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There is one (1) family or one (1) person currently taking temporary shelter in Municipal evacuation centers in Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **40 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 14 families or 41 persons still displaced in Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 11 houses were damaged; of which, eight (8) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P114,678.48** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).

26 March 2025	 DSWD FO VIII closely coordinates with the affected LGUs and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. DSWD FO VIII advised MSWDO to conduct psychosocial support to the affected families. DSWD FO VIII referred the affected families to the Assistance in Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) program for possible financial assistance.
