

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar as of 26 March 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 March 2025 at around 02:35 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar. The fire was declared out at around 04:40 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **41 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There is **one (1) family** or **one (1) person** currently taking temporary shelter in **Municipal evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **40 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **14 families** or **41 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were damaged; of which, **eight (8)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion 2, Talalora, Samar** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱114,678.48** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
