## I. Situation Overview

On 03 March 2025 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Pagkakaisa, Brgy. Sucat, Muntinlupa City. The fire was declared out at around 4:53 PM.

There are seven (7) families or 21 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Sucat, Muntinlupa City (see Annex C).

A total of **P17,121.58** worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex D).
