I. Situation Overview

On 03 March 2025 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Pagkakaisa, Brgy. Sucat, Muntinlupa City. The fire was declared out at around 4:53 PM.

A total of **seven (7) families** or **21 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sucat, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex A).

There are **seven (7) families** or **21 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Sucat, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex C).

A total of **₱17,121.58** worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex D).
