I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2025 at around 4:48 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sulod, Basey, Samar.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sulod, Basey, Samar** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Sulod, Basey, Samar** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,982.88** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
