

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Umagos, Lagonglong, Misamis Oriental

as of 05 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 February 2025 at around 12:50 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Umagos, Lagonglong, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 1:30 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **six (6) families** or **29 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Umagos, Lagonglong, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **17 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Umagos, Lagonglong, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱92,400.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱32,400.00** from **DSWD** and **₱60,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
