

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incidents in Libungan, North Cotabato

as of 05 March 2025, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 04 March 2025 at around 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to Easterlies may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 3:00 PM, several barangays in Libungan, North Cotabato experienced flash floods due to heavy rains caused by Easterlies.
