

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Suspected Case of Measles Outbreak in Brgy. San Agustin, Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro

as of 18 March 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 March 2025, the first confirmed case of measles was reported in Brgy. San Agustin, Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro. As a mitigation response to minimize contact between infected individuals and the broader community, the Local Government of Sablayan placed 242 families under isolation.

In addition to the quarantine protocols, the Local Health Office conducted an anti-measles vaccination campaign on 03 March 2025 as part of the government's proactive efforts to protect residents who may have been exposed to the infected individuals.

Measles is a highly contagious disease caused by a virus which infects the respiratory tract and then spreads throughout the body. It spreads easily when an infected person breathes, coughs or sneezes, and can cause severe disease, complications, and even death. Symptoms include a high fever, cough, runny nose and a rash all over the body.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 242 families or 702 persons are affected in Brgy. San Agustin, Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P765,355.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P215,355.80** from **DSWD** and **P550,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex B).
