

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Easterlies in Davao Region as of 20 March 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 March 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms were observed, attributed to the Easterlies. These conditions may have led to possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains affecting the Davao Region.

On the same day, continuous rainfall due to Easterlies caused flooding and landslides in the municipalities of Mabini, Davao de Oro and Malita, Davao Occidental.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XI, promptly coordinated with the affected Local Government Units (LGUs) to obtain significant updates and explore the possibility of extending resource augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected population.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **5,007 families** or **19,189 persons** are affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **52 families** or **133 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Napnapan, Pantukan, Davao de Oro** (see Annex C).
